Event format	 Individual championships (morning shoot): Recurve, barebow and longbow archers shoot at 122cm faces, 4 archers per boss Compound archers shoot at individual 6-ring 80cm faces, 3 archers per boss Club team (pair) matches: This is an informal trial event! Matches between teams (pairs of archers), each archer shooting 3 arrows. Teams to shoot all 6 arrows in 150 seconds (two and a half minutes). Precise format will depend on number of entries and will be communicated on the day. We are looking to use a format that will see all participating pairs shoot a roughly equal number of matches – i.e. we will not use the traditional head-to-head elimination format. It is likely we will use a format similar to the "Beiter hit-or-miss" events. Note: This is a closed event for archers affiliating to Archery GB via BCAA. 						
Bosses	Straw bosses will be used throughout						

Awards	 Individual championships: Medals and trophies will be awarded based on the number of archers competing in each category: Compound, Recurve, Barebow and Longbow. No other bow styles will be accepted. Only archers shooting their age-appropriate round will be eligible for championship medals and awards. Medals will also be awarded to novice archers (archers who started shooting after October 1st, 2017) with the highest 						
	scores in their category. Team matches: Gold and silver medals in contested categories						
Dress regulations	Rule 307 will apply						
Lost arrows	As we are shooting on a school field, all arrows must be found. It is the responsibility of each archer to retrieve all arrows before leaving the field – the field party will be there to help.
